
Marabu

Easter Egg Cover



Egg Size: app. 6 to 7 cm (2.6") pastic egg

Material: rest of color you like
100% cotton yarn

for decoration:
marabu feathers in
purple and white

hook 1.25 mm (US steel 10)

Abbreviations and Terms

ch...chain stitch
sc...single crochet
sl st...slip stitch
st(s)...stitch(es)
dc...double crochet

INSTRUCTIONS:

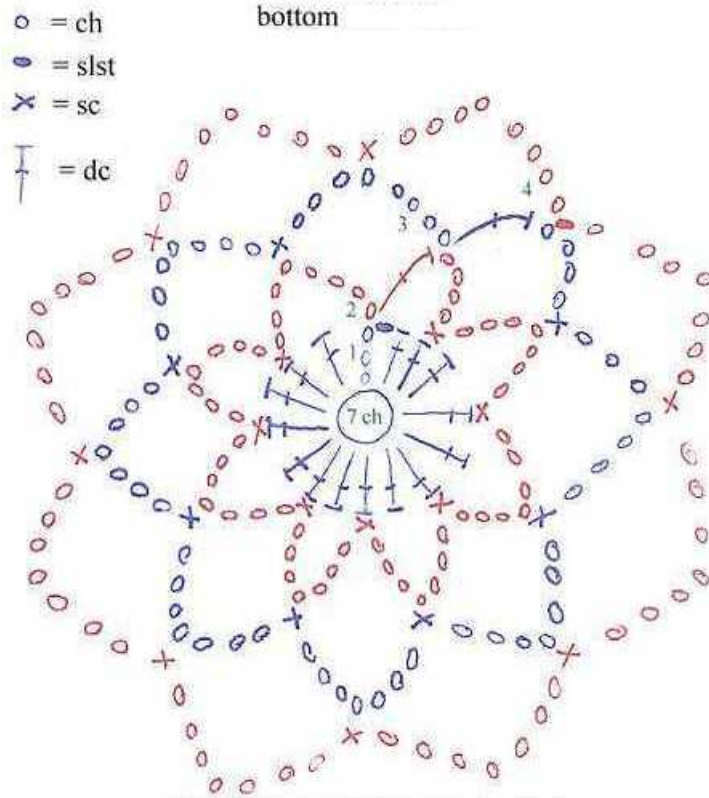
don't forget to put egg in on time

join every round with slst

- begin for bottom with 7 ch, join ring with slst, rd 1: 16 dc in ring, join with slst
- go on like [chart 1](#) shows, fasten off ([bottom: written instruction](#))
- then make edging - [chart 2](#) (fixed with sc at bottom) ([edging: written instruction](#))
- [chart 3](#) shows you how to make the slst-chains (fixed with a sc at edging) ([slst-chain how-to](#))
- you work each of the both slst-chains (22 sts) to the opposite side

put on decoration like picture shows

chart 1 - bottom of egg cover



bottom: written instruction

begin with 7 ch, join to ring with slst

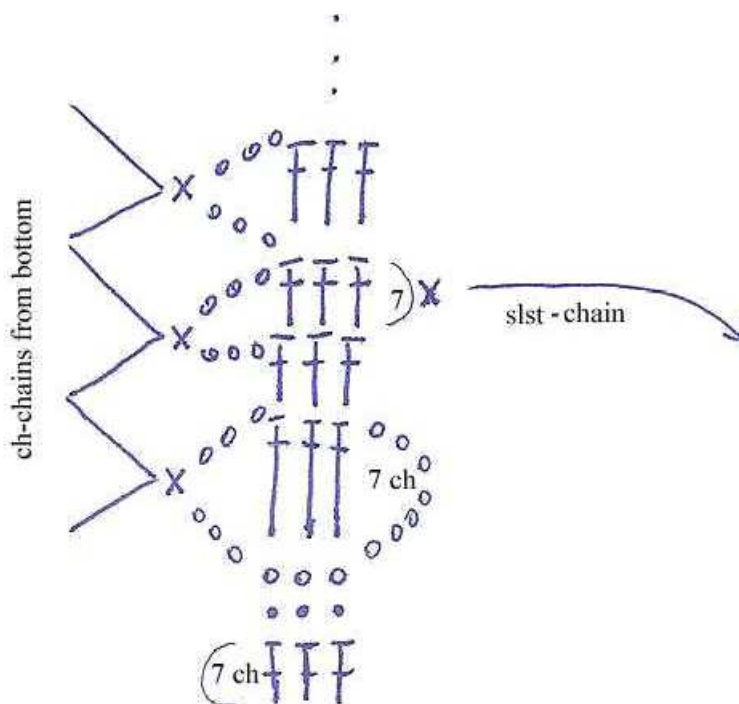
1 R: 16 dc in ring, join with slst

2.R: 1 ch, *7 ch, skip 1 st, 1 sc in next st*, repeat from * to * 6 times, 4 ch, 1 dc in first ch

3.R: 1 ch, *7 ch, 1 sc in next ch-chain*, repeat from * to * 6 times, 4 ch, 1 dc in first ch

4.R: 1 ch, *7 ch, 1 sc in next ch-chain*, repeat from * to * 7 times, join with slst; fasten off

chart 2 - edging



edging: written instruction

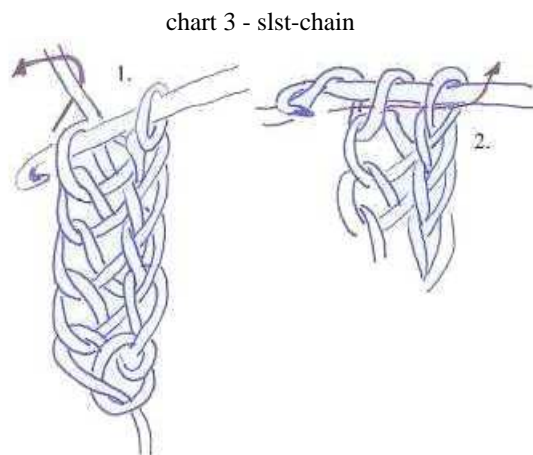
begin with 3 ch

1.R: 7 ch, 1 dc in 8. st from hook, 2 dc, 3 ch, 1 sc in ch-chain of bottom, turn

2.R: 3 ch, 3 dc, 7 ch, 3 dc, 3 ch, 1 sc in ch-chain of bottom, turn

repeat row 2 across

join edging band with slsts at the end



how to do a slst-chain?

1. begin with 2 ch in 1. ch
yo and draw through 1 loop

2. yo and draw through both loops on hook

work 2 slst-chains (22 sts) to the opposite side
join with sc at 7 ch-chain of edging
